In order to be valid, this proxy form and, if such proxy form is signed by a person under a power of attorney or other authority on behalf of the appointer, a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority shall be deposited with the Company's H Share Registrar, Hong Kong Registrars Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 24 hours before the time for holding the meeting or 24 hours before the time appointed for taking the poll.
- 9. A shareholder or his proxy shall produce his own identity proof documentation when attending the meeting. An individual shareholder attending the meeting in person shall produce (i) his own identity document; and (ii) the evidence of his shareholding. A proxy who has been appointed to attend the meeting on behalf of others shall produce (i) his own identity document; (ii) the power of attorney; and (iii) the evidence of shareholding. A corporate shareholder shall be represented at the meeting by its legal representative, or the proxy appointed by the legal representative, or a proxy appointed by the board of directors or other governance body. If a corporate shareholder appoints its legal representative to attend the meeting, the legal representative shall produce (i) his own identity document; (ii) valid proof of his identity as a legal representative; and (iii) the evidence of shareholding. Where a proxy is appointed by the legal representative to attend the meeting on his behalf, the proxy shall produce (i) his own identity document; (ii) the power of attorney duly issued by the legal representative of the corporate shareholder; and (iii) the evidence of shareholding. Where a proxy is appointed to attend the meeting by the board of directors or other governance body of the corporate shareholder, the proxy shall produce (i) his own identity document; (ii) a notarially certified copy of the resolution or authority of appointment; and (iii) the evidence of shareholding.
- 10. Should there be any discrepancies between the Chinese and English versions of this form, the Chinese version shall prevail.
